MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of St. Petersburg Christian University (SPbCU) is to provide accredited higher education based on evangelical values.

BRIEF HISTORY

A resident Bible School was established in 1990 in the Krasnodar region of Southern Russia. In a collective farm village on the eastern edge of the city of Belorechensk, the Russian Bible Institute "Logos" began its operation in the fall of 1990 with 45 students.

In 1992 the Institution was transferred to St. Petersburg, the location of the first evangelical Bible School before the Bolshevik Revolution. The program of studies was extended from one year to 3 years and in 1993 the name was changed to St. Petersburg Christian University.

In April 1999 the university purchased its own buildings on Narvsky prospect and began renovations right away. Both buildings of our campus have been newly renovated.

During graduation in May 2005 St. Petersburg Christian University installed its fifth Rector, Dr. Alexander I. Negrov.

ACADEMICS

Undergraduate programs

BACHELOR OF THEOLOGY PROGRAM

This program is for 4 years and is an intensive program concerned with both personal and community spiritual life, which offers a solid theological foundation. This theological foundation consists of:

- Biblical Interpretation, including Greek and Hebrew.
- Biblical Theology
- Church History, including an emphasis on Russian Church History.
- Russian Culture and Philosophy in light of the Bible
- Practical Theology

Practical ministries, related to this program, are performed by all students in local Churches, orphanages, and Christian summer camps.

BACHELOR OF PASTORAL OF YOUTH

This program of study is for three years and focuses in practical ministry and the sphere of youth ministry. The students of this program will be well grounded in practical theology, various areas of youth ministry and leadership. The students in this program will be required to have extensive practical experience among youth before entering the program as well as during the three years of study at SPCU.

BACHELOR OF CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

This program of study is for three years and focuses in the practical ministry sphere as well as in the educational sphere. The students of this program will be well grounded in practical theology, various areas of pedagogy as well as small group organization and leadership. The students in this program will be required to have extensive practical experience among children and youth before entering the program as well as during the three years of study at SPbCU. These areas of experience while at SPbCU will come from active participation in a Church ministry while studying and then practical ministry experience that will be organized during the summer months.

MASTER OF THEOLOGY IN BIBLICAL STUDIES

SPbCU offers a M.Th. program on the SPbCU campus in the British research degree format. This program is a 2 years full time or a 3 years part time. Classes are held on the SPbCU campus and the full time students will remain on the SPbCU campus to do their writing and research as well. The degree is then validated and issued by the University of Wales in United Kingdom. The focus of this program is to train lecturers for Bible Schools, Christian Colleges, and Christian Universities.
